CPCA is a customer driven organization recognized by the community for its outstanding services and being a catalyst for community action and the families we serve.

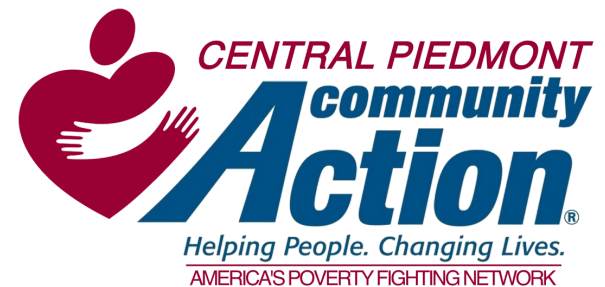
CPCA'S BACKGROUND

Central Piedmont Community Action, Inc. (CPCA) is a private non-profit human service organization established in March 1966 by the Board of Commissioners of Orange and Chatham Counties to seek funds to administer programs to provide services to low-income families and individuals. Programs are developed and approved under the guidance of local Board of Directors consisting of representatives from the private, public, and low-income sectors of the counties. CPCA mobilizes resources from federal, state, and local governments and private foundations to assist low-income families, individuals, and communities.

**Ending Homelessness
in Chatham County**



What is RRH?

Rapid re-housing provides short-term rental assistance and services. The goals are to help people obtain housing quickly, increase self-sufficiency, and stay housed. It is offered without preconditions (such as employment, income, absence of criminal record, or sobriety) and the resources and services provided are typically tailored to the needs of the person.

Rapid re-housing is a primary solution for ending homelessness. It has been demonstrated to be effective in getting people experiencing homelessness into permanent housing and keeping them there. By connecting people with a home, they are in a better position to address other challenges that may have led to their homelessness, such as obtaining employment or addressing substance abuse issues.

Services Offered Under RRH

Assists with housing relocation and stabilization services and short-and or medium-term rental support as necessary to help individuals or families living in shelters or in places not meant for human habitation move as quickly as possible into permanent housing and achieve stability in that housing. Services intended to help participants gain housing stability may include:

- Housing Stability Case Management
- Housing Search & Placement
- Rental Application Fee Assistance
- Security Deposit & Last Month's Rent Assistance
- Utility Deposit and Payment Assistance
- Landlord-Tenant Mediation
- Tenant Legal Services
- Moving Cost Assistance
- Credit Repair

Specific client services are based on the individual needs of participants and the availability of funds.

Eligibility Requirements

Services are offered in Chatham County. Program eligibility is based on applicant residing in Chatham County. Documentation required includes, but is not limited to: Certification that the individual or family is experiencing homelessness (e.g. living in an emergency shelter, on the streets, or in an uninhabitable location without a home); additional guidelines will be provided at time of application.
