

Highlights of 2022-23 Program Year

The Community Services Block Grant program served 160 families. 28 of the projected 15 customers moved above the poverty income levels or 187%.

The Weatherization Assistance program weatherized 80 of the 81 contracted units or 99%.

The Rapid Rehousing program housed 28 out of a projected 12 households. The 28 households consisted of 95 individuals.

Randolph CSBG Case Manager James Martin was honored to represent CPCA at the ribbon cutting ceremony for Lydia's Place on October 24, 22. Lydia's Place is the first emergency shelter in Randolph County for women and families experiencing homelessness.

Thanks to another generous donation this program year from PNC Bank, we were able to sponsor 20 families for Thanksgiving. The contribution made it possible for us to provide a turkey, sides, and all the fixings for families in need.
